

ORDINANCE NO. 2-45

Providing for reimbursement to George M. Morris for cost of constructing sewer outlet at Nos. 747-9, 751-3-5 Sheridan Avenue.
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. WHEREAS, in reconstructing certain portions of the curbing in front of the premises of George M. Morris at Nos. 747-9, 751-3-5 Sheridan Avenue, the city inadvertently closed the outlets for roof drainage of the above premises and said George M. Morris has expended the sum of \$5.35 for labor and material in providing such outlets and the City Council is of the opinion that due to said fault of the City it should reimburse said George M. Morris for the expense he has been put to in remedying the defect, it is ordained that the City shall reimburse said expense in said amount, and the Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to issue a voucher in payment thereof. The amount of \$5.35 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for this purpose.

Section 2. This ordinance shall go into full force and effect upon the passage thereof.
