RESOLUTION NO. 3-45

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

That sidewalks shall be constructed on the south side of Main Street from a point 41 feet east of Cassingham Avenue eastwardly a distance of 109.67 feet, being across the frontage of property belonging to Lillian R. Mohler, of the character and in the manner as follows:

Said sidewalks shall be constructed of concrete in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor heretofore adopted by council and now on file in the office of the Mayor; the same shall be 5 feet in width with a cross slope of three-eighths of an inch per foot, and shall be placed with the inside edge, being the edge next to the lot line, 10 feet from the curb line. The grade of the inside edge or the edge next to the lot line shall be three-eighths of an inch above the curb for each foot the same is distant from the curb, plus one inch rise at the curb.

The Clerk is hereby directed to cause a written notice of the passage of this resolution to be served as required by law.
