Provided, further, that the appropriation for Contingencies can only be expended upon approval of a two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the city, and for the purposes other than those covered by the other specific appropriations herein made.

Section 27. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
