Granting permission to place Memorial to men of Armed Service of the United States of Second World War on municipal grounds.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:


That permission is hereby granted to the Bexley Memorial Committee of the American Legion, Post No. 30, of Bexley, and the Bexley Lions Club to place the Memorial to the Bexley men of the Armed Services of the United States of the Second World War, which has been procured by said committee through popular subscription, on the municipal grounds at No. 2242 East Main Street, at such location thereon as may be designated by the Mayor.

Be it further resolved that said Memorial shall be maintained by said Memorial Committee, and in the event that any future building or development of said grounds by the City of Bexley shall require the relocating of said Memorial thereon, the same shall be done by said Memorial Committee at its expense.
