## ORDINANCE NO. 11-45

By Mr. Harlor

Providing for the resurfacing and repairing of certain asphaltic streets, roads and avenues; and curbs and gutters, in the City of Bexley, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That whereas, the following streets, roads and avenues, to-wit:

- 1. Ardmore Road, from Fair Avenue to Broad Street;
- 2. Cassingham Road from Elm Avenue to approximately 200 feet north of Denver Avenue;
- 3. Cassingham Road from Livingston Avenue to Main Street;
- 4. Roosevelt Avenue from Livingston Avenue to Main Street; Livingston Avenue
- 5. Grandon Avenue from Aximxxxxxxxxxxxx to Charles Street, and from Astor Avenue to Mound Street;
- 6. Chelsea Avenue from Livingston Avenue to Charles Street, and from Astor Avenue to Mound Street;

proper highways, said streets, roads and avenues shall be repaired by resurfacing the same with asphaltic concrete, and repairing the base and the curbs and gutters thereof, in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles thereof heretofore prepared by the engineers and on file in the office of the Mayor, and which are hereby approved.

Section 2. That the entire cost of said repairs shall be paid by the City. The following sums are hereby appropriated from the following funds for the payment thereof, to-wit:

\$8,000.00 from Street Maintenance & Repair (MVL) Fund \$5,000.00 from Street Maintenance & Repair (Gas) Fund \$51,200.00 from General Fund

Section 3. That the Layor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract or contracts for said repairs after advertisement according to law.
