

ORDINANCE NO. 13-45

Providing for modification of salary of assistant superintendent of water.

WHEREAS, by reason of the present economic conditions council has heretofore modified the salary of certain appointive officials and employees, and now deems it expedient and proper to provide for a modification and increase in the salary of the assistant superintendent of water, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That from and after the effective date of this ordinance and until further action by council, the salary of the assistant superintendent of water be, and the same is, hereby increased ten per centum (10%) over and above the salary provided for said position by Ordinance No. 1-39.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period provided by law.
