
Reappropriating moneys within the appropriation for the
Recreational Department.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars
is hereby reappropriated from the 1-M-2 appropriation within the
Recreation Fund to the 1-M-4 appropriation within the Recreation
Fund in the General Fund for the current operation of the
Recreation Department.


Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and
effect from and after the earliest period provided by law.


