

ORDINANCE NO. 22-45

By Mr. Bonnet

Authorizing the Mayor to obtain appraisal of real estate hereinafter described.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That whereas, the city is contemplating the purchase of premises at Nos. 2230-2232 East Main Street, in the City of Bexley, for municipal purposes, the Mayor is hereby authorized and empowered to have an appraisal of said premises made by the Columbus Real Estate Board.

Section 2. The sum of \$75.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to pay the cost of said appraisal.

Section 3. This ordinance will take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
