## ORDINANCE NO. 23-45

By Mr. Stackhouse

Transferring funds within the water Fund for the purchase of addressograph, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That for the payment of the cost of an addressograph together with cabinet and stand purchased by the superintendent of water for the use of the Water Department, there is hereby appropriated from the unappropriated funds in the Water Fund to 6 A 3 fund, the sum of \$196.00.

Section 2. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
