Declaring the intention to appropriate property for the purpose of opening and extending Pleasant Ridge Avenue in the City of Bexley, Ohio.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BENLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Council deems it necessary, and hereby declares its intention to appropriate, for opening and extending Pleasant Ridge Avenue, the following described real property, in fee, situate in the County of Franklin State of Ohio and City of Bexley, to-wit:

Being part of Lot No. Four (4) of Edward Livingston's Heirs' Subdivision, as the same is numbered and delineated upon the recorded plat thereof, of record in Plat Book No. 2, page 278, Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio, and being more perticularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pipe in the north line of said Lot 4 of Edward Livingston's Heirs' Subdivision, and in the east line of Pleasant Ridge Avenue, as the same is shown of record, on the plat of C. F. Woehlert's Amended Subdivision as recorded in Plat Book 7, page 206, Franklin County Recorder's Office; thence southerly with the east line of Pleasant Ridge Avenue, produced 66.92 ft. to the southeast corner of said Devine's .087 acre tract and in the north line of a 1.62 acre tract formerly owned by Charles E. Nixon and Harley L.
