

ORDINANCE NO. 6-46

Approving and confirming the purchase of a Chevrolet Box Bed Truck for use of the Service Department.

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Service requires an additional truck for use in its daily operations, and the city had the opportunity to purchase the required type of truck, being a Chevrolet Box Bed Truck Chassis, Model NJ-21, Motor No. 483807, Manufacturer's Serial No. 3420, from the War Assets Corporation, at a great saving in the cost thereof, and,

WHEREAS, in order to obtain said truck it was necessary to take advantage of said opportunity without the delay necessary for advertising for bids, and further that under present conditions it would be futile to advertise for bids for such type of truck, as the same can be obtained from only the one source, and competitive bids could not be received therefor, and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor has completed said purchase at the cost of \$975.00, and has received the certificate of title for said truck, NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the action of the Mayor and Auditor, in the purchase of said truck, be and the same is hereby approved and confirmed, and the sum of \$975.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the payment therefor.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
