

ORDINANCE NO. 7-46

By Mr. Harlor

Providing for the purchase of a Packer type refuse body and automobile chassis therefor, for the collection of garbage and refuse, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of one Packer type refuse body, and chassis for same, for use in the collection of garbage and refuse, said body type to be fully enclosed and designed to obtain the utmost in the way of sanitary conditions and construction, the same to be fully equipped for use according to specifications, as the Mayor may deem proper and best.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law. Such advertisement shall provide that bids will be received for such body and chassis separately, and for body and chassis combined. The sum of \$6,500.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that additional trucks for collection of garbage are immediately necessary, and this ordinance shall go into full force and effect upon the passage thereof.
