## ORDINANCE NO. 10-46

Providing for the employment of architects for the construction of a building for public halls, municipal offices and for the use of the departments of public service and safety, and garage.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF Ohio:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in the name and on behalf of the City of Bexley, with the architectural firm of Inscho, Brand and Inscho for the preparation of plans for a building to be located on East Main Street at the site of the present municipal buildings and additional lands to be acquired therefor, for public halls and municipal offices, and for the use of the departments of public service and public safety, and a garage building, and for the general supervision of the construction thereof.

Section 2. That the sum of \$5,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the payment of the fees of said architects in accordance with said contract, and for necessary expenses incidental to said contract by way of making necessary surveys, borings and tests for the information of said architects.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
