## ORDINANCE NO. 11-46

Accepting the plat of Bexley Woods Addition and confirming the dedication of streets, avenues, drives and easements thereon.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the plat of Bexley Woods Addition, being a sub-division of ten (10) acres of ground on the west side of North Cassady Road, known as the Bennignus tract of Bexley Woods, Incorporated, be and the same is hereby approved and accepted, and that the dedication to public use of the streets, avenues, drives and easements thereon shown be and the same is hereby accepted and confirmed.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
