ORDINANCE NO. 12-46

Authorizing the purchase of materials for the maintenance and repair of streets for the balance of the year, 1946, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they are hereby authorized, after advertisement had according to law, to enter into contracts for the purchase and delivery of the following meterials for the maintenance and repair of the various streets and avenues in the City of Bexley for the balance of the year, 1946, to-wit:

Asphalt Emulsion 8000 gallons
Tar and Asphalt applied on road

12000 gallons

Mastic and 200 tons
Asphalt 200 tons
Concrete 200 yards

Section 2. That the sum of \$9,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the purpose of paying the cost of secondarials.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the signaliste preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and emergency being that said streets are in need of immediate repair, and this spatiance shall go into force and effect upon the passage thereof.
