To amend Section 3 (a) of Ordinance No. 95-31 establishing administrative departments for the City of Bexley, as amended by Ordinance No. 3-33, passed January 24, 1933, Ordinance No. 24-24, passed September 26, 1944 and Ordinance No. 12-45, passed May 22, 1945.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BENLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 5 (a) of Ordinance No. 93-31, establishing administrative departments for the City of Bexley, passed December 22, 1931, as amended by Ordinance No. 3-33, passed January 24, 1933, Ordinance No. 24-44, passed September 26, 1944, and Ordinance No. 18-45, passed May 22, 1945, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3 (a) The Division of Police, or Police Department shall be composed of the following officers and other members who shall receive the respective salaries hereinafter provided.

- (1) A Chief of Police who shall be appointed by the Mayor from names or lists submitted by the Civil Service Commission in accordance with law; he shall receive a salary of \$255.00 per month, payable semi-monthly.
- (2) Three Police Sergeants who shall be appointed by the Mayor from names or lists submitted by the Civil Service Commission in accordance with law; each shall receive a salary of \$215.00 per month, payable semi-monthly.
- (3) Not to exceed twelve patrolmen, who shall be appointed by the Mayor from lists submitted by the Civil Service Commission in accordance with law; the salaries of said patrolmen shall be dependent upon their length of service, and shall be as follows, to-wit:

For the first six months, \$170.00 per month, payable semi-monthly;
For the second six months, \$175.00 per month, payable semi-monthly;
For the second year, \$185.00 per month, payable semi-monthly;
For the third and subsequent years, \$200.00 per month, payable semi-monthly.

Provided, however, such persons as have been continuously in the service of the municipality for two years next preceding the first day of January, 1932, may be appointed to this Department to serve until discharged, reduced, promoted or transferred in accordance with the provisions of the Charter. The duties of the Chief and other members of the Dep rtment shall be as prescribed by the Charter and the statutes of Ohio, or by ordinance of Council hereafter enacted. They shall also serve notices and enforce the rules and regulations of the Board of Health and other Boards, as directed by the Mayor, and shall maintain and keep in good condition all police tomobiles, motorcycles, radios, and other equipment used by this Department. They shall also perform such duties in connection with the rire Department as may be required by the Mayor or Chief of the Fire Department until otherwise provided by ordinance.

Section 2. That said Section E (a) of Ordinance No. 93-31 establishing administrative departments for the City of Bexley, passed December 22, 1931, as amended by Ordinance No. 3-33, passed January 24, 1933, Ordinance No. 24-44, passed deptember 26, 1944, and Ordinance No. 12-45, passed May 22, 1945, and all other Ordinances in conflict herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the 1st day of July, 1946.
