Reappropriating moneys within the appropriation for the
Water Department.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

That the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00) is
hereby reappropriated from the X-6-J-23 appropriation within
the Water Fund to the 6-F-1 appropriation within the Water Fund
for the current operation of the Water Department.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and
effect from and after the earliest period provided by law.

Passed July 9, 1946.


