

ORDINANCE NO. 26-46

Providing for modification of salaries of certain appointive officials and employees.

Whereas, by reason of the present economic conditions Council deems it expedient and proper to provide for an increase in salaries of certain appointive officials and employees of the City hereinafter specifically set forth, NOW, THEREFORE:


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That from and after August 15, 1946, and until further action by the council, the salaries of the following appointive officials and employees be and the same are hereby increased ten percentum (10%) over and above the salaries provided for said respective positions during the year 1946, to-wit:

- (a) Superintendent of Streets
- (b) Superintendent of Building
- (c) Asst. Superintendent of Water
- (d) Superintendent of Parks
- (e) Custodian of Jeffrey Property
- (f) Equipment Maintenance Mechanic


Section 2. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the 15th day of August, 1946.
