To authorize contract to make certain alterations in basement of Jeffrey house to provide space for a shooting range, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ONDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

6 Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are
hereby authorized to enter into a contract, after advertisement
according to law, for the making of alterations necessary to
provide room of sufficient length for a shooting range in the
north end of the recreation room in the basement of the Jeffrey
house on North Parkview Avenue, by removing approximately twenty
feet of a 17-inch brick wall, and providing proper support
thereof, all in accordance with the specifications heretofore
prepared therefor and now on file in the office of the Mayor,
which are hereby approved.

Section 2. That the sum of \$2,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the general fund for the above purpose.

Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace and safety, and the same shall go into full force and effect upon the passage thereof.
