Accepting deed of T. B. Devine and Geraldine A. Devine, his wife, for premises in the City of Bexley, Ohio, as here-inafter described.

WHEREAS, T. B. Devine and Geraldine A. Devine, his wife, has executed to the City of Bexley their certain deed for the following described real estate, situate in County of Franklin, State of Ohio and City of Bexley and bounded and described as follows:

Section 2. That the sum of \$750.00 be, and the same is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the payment of the consideration for said deed.

Section 3. That the Clerk be, and he hereby is directed to certify upon said deed the acceptance whereof by Council by this ordinance and to file the same for record in the Recorder's Office of Franklin County, Ohio.
