ORDINANCE NO. 41-46

Appropriating and transferring funds from unappropriated moneys in the General Fund to the appropriations hereinafter set forth, and declaring an emergency.

To the 2 A 1 appropriation in the Safety Fund, \$384.78, To the 4 K 1 appropriation in the Service Fund, \$123.75, To the 4 K 7 appropriation in the Service Fund, \$96.57, To the 15 A 1 appropriation in the Park Fund, \$86.67.

Section 2. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the public peace, health and safety, and the same shall go into immediate force and effect.
