

## ORDINANCE NO. 42-46


Reappropriating moneys within the appropriation for  
the Recreation Fund in the General Fund.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF  
OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars  
(\$250.00) is hereby reappropriated from the 1-M-2 appropriation  
in the Recreation Fund of the General Fund and the sum of One  
Hundred Twenty Six Dollars (\$126.00) is hereby reappropriated  
from the 1-M-5 appropriation within the Recreation Fund of the  
General Fund to the 1-M-3 appropriation within the Recreation  
Fund for the current operation of the Recreation Department.


Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force
