
Appropriating and transferring moneys within the Water Fund and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That for the purpose of paying salaries in the Water Department there is hereby appropriated and transferred from the unappropriated moneys in the Water Fund to the 6 A 3 appropriation in the Water Fund the sum of \$74.25.


Section 2. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the public peace, health and safety, and the same shall go into immediate force and effect.
