

## ORDINANCE NO. 47-46


Repealing Ordinance No. 20-44, passed July 25, 1944.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That whereas Ordinance No. 20-44, passed July 25, 1944, entitled "Ordinance No. 20-44, Granting license to the East End Development Company as owner, and Herbert Linick as Lessee, to connect with and tap into sanitary sewer in the North Stanwood Road, and declaring an emergency," was passed as a defense measure, and the same not having been acted upon by the property owners and the lessee therein named, and there being no further emergency for said sewerage provisions, said ordinance is hereby repealed.


Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
