ORDINANCE NO. 3-47

By Mr. Stackhouse

Prohibiting the display of weapons for sale.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to exhibit for sale in show cases or show windows, revolvers, daggers, stilettos, brass or iron knuckles and billies, or to display any signs, posters, cartoons or display cards, suggesting the sale of any revolvers, daggers, stilettos, brass or iron knuckles and billies.

Section 2. Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, be fined not to exceed Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) and the costs of prosecution.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
