

RESOLUTION NO. 4-47

Granting permit to the College of St. Charles Borromeo to connect lights on ornamental pillars to the city street lighting system.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That permission is hereby granted to the College of St. Charles Borromeo, of 2010 East Broad Street to connect lights on the two ornamental pillars being constructed by said college at its Broad Street entrance to the college campus with the street lighting system of the City in such manner that the same will be operated concurrently with the city lights. The cost of current consumed shall be computed upon the candle power of the lighting bulbs used in said lights at the same rate as such current is charged to the city and the city shall bill the college therefor each six months and said bill shall be paid within thirty days thereafter.

Section 2. Said lights shall be installed in accordance with electric code of the city and under the supervision of the City's electric inspection and the cost of permit and inspection shall be paid by the college.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
