

ORDINANCE NO. 23-47

By Mr. Kurtz

Providing for modification of salaries of certain appointive officials and employees.

Whereas, by reason of the present economic conditions Council deems it expedient and proper to provide for an increase in salaries of certain appointive officials and employees of the City hereinafter specifically set forth, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BREWLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That from and after the effective date of this ordinance and until further action of Council, the salaries of the following appointive officials and employees shall be as follows:

- (a) Chief of Police, \$280.00
- (b) Police Sergeants, \$240.00
- (c) Patrolmen, \$25.00 increase above prevailing salary scale as set forth in Ordinance No. 21-46
- (d) Equipment Maintenance Mechanic, \$261.00
- (e) Superintendent of Parks, \$236.00
- (f) Custodian of Jeffrey Property, \$182.00
- (g) Secretary to the Mayor and Auditor, \$165.00
- (h) Superintendent of Streets, \$330.00
- (i) Superintendent of Building, \$510.00
- (j) Superintendent of Water, \$230.00

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after the fifteenth day of August, 1947.
