ORDINANCE NO. 25-47

Appropriating and transferring moneys in the various funds herein provided and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That for the purpose of paying wages and purchasing supplies within the various departments, there be and hereby are appropriated and transferred within the following funds the following sums, to-wit:

- (a) In the Motor Vehicle License Fund, from 11-A-7 fund to 11-A-6 fund, the sum of \$1000.00.
- (b) In the Park Fund in the Service Fund, from 15-B-20 fund to 15-B-3 fund, the sum of \$1000.00.
- (c) In the Service Fund, from 4-K-9 fund to 4-M-6 fund, the sum of \$3000.00.

Section 2. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and the same shall go into immediate force and effect.
