Providing penalty for permitting a minor to operate a motor vehicle, unless licensed under Driver's License Law.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:


Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to cause or knowingly permit any minor under the age of eighteen (18) years to drive a motor vehicle upon a highway within the City of Bexley as an operator, unless such minor shall have first obtained a license or permit to so drive a motor vehicle under the provisions of the Driver's License Law of Ohio.


Section 2. It shall be a misdemeanor for any person to violate the provisions of this Ordinance, and upon conviction thereof, such person shall be fined not to exceed \$50.00 together with the cost of prosecution.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
