ORDINANCE NO. 34-47

By Mr. Altmaier

Prohibiting the employment of unlicensed chauffeur.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. No person shall employ any chauffeur to operate a motor vehicle on or over a public highway in the City of Bexley who is not licensed, as provided by the Driver's License Law of Ohio.

Section 2. It shall be a misdemeanor for any person to violate the provisions of this Ordinance, and upon conviction thereof, such person shall be fined not to exceed \$50.00 together with the cost of prosecution.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
