

RESOLUTION NO. 2-48

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

That sidewalks shall be constructed on both sides of the following streets, and highways in the City of Bexley, between the following points, to-wit:

1. Cassingham Road, from Main Street to Livingston Avenue
2. Montrose Avenue, from Main Street to Livingston Avenue
3. Remington Road, from Main Street to Livingston Avenue
4. Remington Road, from Powell Avenue to Broad Street
5. Stanwood Road, from Powell Avenue to Broad Street
6. Cassingham Road, from Broad Street to Ruhl Avenue
7. Remington Road, from Broad Street to Maryland Avenue
8. Main Street, from Remington Road to Gould Road
9. Fair Avenue, from Drexel Avenue to Gould Road
10. Astor Avenue, from College Avenue to Pleasant Ridge Avenue
11. Vernon Road, from Main Street to Livingston Avenue
12. Roosevelt Avenue, from Main Street to Livingston Avenue
13. Euclaire Avenue, from North Havenwood Drive to Livingston Avenue
14. Sheridan Avenue, from Main Street to Livingston Avenue
15. Ardmore Road, from Broad Street to Ruhl Avenue
16. Bryden Road, from Remington Road to Gould Road

48. Maryland Avenue, from Parkview Avenue to Cassady Road

Said sidewalks shall be constructed of concrete and shall be of the uniform width of four feet, unless a different width shall be ordered by the Mayor in order to conform to existing sidewalks.

Said sidewalks shall be constructed in accordance with the plans and specifications for sidewalks heretofore adopted by Council and now on file in the office of the Mayor; they shall be constructed with a cross-slope of 3/8ths of an inch per foot, and shall be placed with the inside edge, being the edge next to the lot line, two feet from the lot line, and at an elevation above the curb grade of 3/8ths of an inch for each foot that the sidewalk is distant from the curb, plus an inch rise at the curb; provided, however, the Mayor may, by special order, direct a different location with reference to lot lines, or a different slope or elevation for any sidewalk to conform with grades and locations of existing sidewalks. Said sidewalks to be constructed within 60 days after the service of notice of the passage of this resolution.

The foot of the terrace slope of any lot shall not extend into the street beyond the property line.

That the clerk of Council shall, and he is hereby directed to, cause a written notice of the passage of this resolution to be served as required by law.
