

ORDINANCE NO. 3-48

Accepting the deed of Clara Corbett for part of Lot Number Eight (8) of George N. Tussing's Subdivision.

WHEREAS, Clara Corbett has executed her certain deed to the City of Bexley, under date of January 23, 1948, conveying to the City 146 feet off of the north end of Lot Number Eight (8) of George N. Tussing's Subdivision in the City of Bexley, as shown upon Plat Book No. 5, page 74, Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio, and whereas it will be for the best interest of the City to accept said conveyance for use in constructing municipal buildings thereon, NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the deed of Clara Corbett conveying to the City of Bexley the above described 146 feet off of the north end of Lot Number Eight (8) of George N. Tussing's Subdivision bearing the above date be and the same is hereby accepted, and the clerk of Council is hereby directed to certify upon said deed the acceptance thereof by Council and to file the same for record in the Recorder's Office of Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 2. That the sum of \$2,200. is hereby appropriated from the general fund for the payment of the consideration price of said premises, and the further sum of \$50.00 is appropriated from said general fund for the payment of expenses incurred in the acquisition of said property and the recording of the deed, and the proper officials are hereby authorized and directed to issue vouchers of the City in payment thereof.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
