## ORDINANCE NO. 5-48

By Mr.

Providing for salary of Recreation Director and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. WHEREAS, the Recreation Board has reported to Council the employment of William Bernlohr as Recreation Director on a one-half time basis from February 15, 1948 to June 1, 1948, and on a full time basis from June 1, 1948 to September 1, 1948, Council does hereby confirm such appointment for said period and does hereby fix the salary of the Recreation Director at the rate of \$135.33 per month from February 15, 1948 to June 1, 1948, payable semi-monthly, and from and after June 1, 1948 the salary of the Director of Recreation shall be at the rate of \$266.66 per month.

Section 2. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the public peace, health, and safety, said emergency being that the operation of the Recreation Department is dependent upon the Director, and the same shall go into immediate force and effect.
