ORDINANCE NO. 6-48

Providing for purchase of Industrial Tractor with equipment such as dozer and loader, and declaring an emergency. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of one industrial tractor with equipment such as dozer and loader.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law. The sum of \$5,500.00 is hereby appropriated from the _ Fund for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said industrial tractor and equipment is necessary for the operations of the City's governmental functions and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
