

RESOLUTION NO. 8-48

Authorizing the serving of notices and letting of contract for the improvement of Powell Avenue from Parkview Avenue to Drexel Avenue.

WHEREAS, on the 8th day of September, 1942, the Council of the City of Bexley duly adopted Resolution No. 14-42, declaring it necessary to improve Powell Avenue from Parkview Avenue to Drexel Avenue in the manner therein described, and did thereafter on the 27th day of October, 1942, adopt Resolution No. 15-42 amending said resolution, and did thereafter on the 27th day of November, 1942, duly pass Ordinance No. 57-42 determining to proceed with said improvement, and

WHEREAS, by reason of intervention of World War II, it was impossible to proceed with said improvement at that time for lack of materials and inability to receive bids therefor, and said improvement was delayed until such time as materials might be available, and

WHEREAS, Council is of the opinion that conditions are now such as to warrant the letting of a contract and making of said improvement, NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

That the Clerk be and he is hereby authorized to serve notice on the owners of property to be assessed for said improvement of Powell Avenue from Parkview Avenue to Drexel Avenue, notifying them of the passage of said resolutions in accordance with the law, and that the Mayor and Auditor be directed to proceed to let a contract for said improvement after advertisement according to law.
