

ORDINANCE NO. 9-48

By Mr. Harlor

Authorizing the purchase of materials for the maintenance and repair of streets for the balance of the year, 1948, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they are hereby authorized, after advertisement according to law, to enter into contracts for the purchase and delivery of the following materials for the maintenance and repair of the various streets and avenues in the City of Bexley for the balance of the year, 1948, to-wit:

Asphalt Emulsion	5,000 gallons
Tar and Asphalt applied on road	23,000 gallons
Mastic Sand	130 tons
Asphaltic Concrete	400 tons
Concrete	50 yards
Gravel and Stone	650 tons

Section 2. That the sum of \$9,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the purpose of paying the cost of said materials.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said streets are in need of immediate repair, and this ordinance shall go into force and effect upon the passage thereof.
