

ORDINANCE NO. 13-48

By Mr. Kurtz

Authorizing the purchase of materials and entering into contract for the application thereof for the control of mosquitoes and flies, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized to purchase, in lots of approximately 700 gallons each, the necessary kerosene solution and the necessary amounts of D D T and Pine Oil ingredients for spraying and dusting along the streets, alleys, streams and lands within the City for mosquitoes and fly control, said separate purchases to total an approximate amount of 2,000 gallons of kerosene and the other ingredients necessary to mix with same to produce proper spray similar to and equal to Geigly Patents insecticidal solutions; and that they be authorized to contract with and employ the Tornado Manufacturing Company, represented by H. K. Steckel, its agent, to mix such solution and apply same by use of its spraying apparatus, known as fog machine upon the basis of \$10.00 per hour or \$75.00 per day of 8 hours. Said Company to furnish the necessary machinery, operators, fuel and all other things necessary to properly spray and apply said mixture so to be furnished by the City.

Section 2. That the sum of \$3,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the general fund for the above purposes.

Section 3. WHEREAS the apparatus and machinery necessary for the application of said spray is obtainable only from said Tornado Manufacturing Company, and advertising for bids would be futile and a useless expense as there could be no competitive bids received therefor, and whereas said ingredients are to be purchased in small lots from time to time and the aggregate cost thereof will not exceed \$500.00, the Mayor and Auditor are authorized to enter into the necessary agreements and to make the necessary purchases without advertisement for bids first had.

Section 4. This ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the public peace, health, and safety, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
