

RESOLUTION NO. 13-48

By Mr. Kurtz

Be it Resolved and hereby determined by the Council of the City of Bexley, Franklin County, Ohio, that it is necessary for the purpose of constructing a swimming pool and dressing and locker rooms in connection therewith, which shall be of fire-proof construction, and constructing walks and parking areas for use in connection therewith, to issue and sell Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) of bonds of said City. Said bonds shall be dated approximately the 1st day of April, 1949, and shall bear interest at not to exceed 2% per annum; said bonds shall mature as follows:

and that it is necessary that there shall be annually levied on all the taxable property in the City of Bexley, Franklin County, Ohio, a direct tax outside of the ten mill limitation, to pay the interest on and to retire the said bonds; and be it further

Resolved, That the question of issuing bonds in the sum of \$200,000.00 be submitted to the electors of said City at the regular election to be held at the usual voting places within said City on the 2nd day of November, 1948; and be it further

Resolved, That the form of the ballots to be used at said election shall be as follows:

Shall bonds be issued by the City of Bexley for the purpose of constructing a swimming pool and dressing and locker

rooms in connection therewith, which shall be of fire-proof construction, and constructing walks and parking areas for use in connection therewith in the sum of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars and a levy of taxes be made outside of the ten mill limitation, estimated by the County Auditor to average .85 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to eight and one-half (8½) cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for a maximum period of 20 years to pay the principal and interest of such bonds.
