

## RESOLUTION NO. 14-48

GRANTING LICENSE FOR OCCUPANCY OF PREMISES AT NO. 2230 EAST MAIN STREET.

WHEREAS, at the time of acquiring by appropriation the store-room at No. 2230 East Main Street, the same being then occupied by Mark K. Merkle and Margaret Merkle for restaurant purposes, and the City, not then determining to proceed immediately to raze said building for the purposes for which said premises were appropriated, did permit <sup>the said</sup> Mark K. Merkle and Margaret Merkle to continue to occupy said store-room at and during the sufferance of the City upon the payment to the City at the rate of \$65.00 per month, and

WHEREAS, the said Merkles have ceased to occupy said premises and have relinquished the possession thereof to Victoria Halby, who is now conducting a restaurant business therein, NOW THEREFORE:  
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

That the right to the occupancy of said building by the said Mark K. Merkle and Margaret Merkle be and the same is terminated and revoked, and there is hereby granted to the said Victoria Halby the right and license to occupy said store-room for restaurant purposes from and after the 5th day of November, 1948, but said right and license to be only at the sufferance of the Council of the City of Bexley, the said Victoria Halby paying to said City for said license and right of occupancy at the rate of \$65.00 per month in advance; that said license shall not be assignable; and if said Victoria Halby shall cease to occupy said premises, or shall fail to pay any said payment when due under her said license, said license shall thereupon be revoked without further action or notice by Council; and Council may revoke said license at any time.

This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
