

ORDINANCE NO. 15-48

Providing for the appointment of an assistant Clerk of Council for the purpose of serving notices, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Auditor be and he is hereby authorized to appoint an Assistant Clerk of Council for the purpose of serving notices of the passage of resolutions and other proceedings of Council, and such other notices and reports as are required by law to be served upon property owners. The salary of said Assistant Clerk shall be \$8.00 per day for each day for which he is actually engaged in such service. Said salary to be paid out of the general fund.

Section 2. That the sum of \$500. be and the same is hereby appropriated from the general fund for the payment of said salary for the year 1948.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that certain improvements are in progress for which notices must be served at once, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
