

ORDINANCE NO. 21-48

Appropriating money for the payment of that portion of the cost of improving Powell Avenue from Parkview Avenue to Drexel Avenue which is to be borne by the City.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 57-42, passed November 27, 1942, there was appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$16,000.00 for the purpose of paying 60% of the cost, and the cost of intersections, for the improvement of Powell Avenue from Parkview Avenue to Drexel Avenue, as described in said ordinance, and which appropriation has now expired, and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of said improvement has been amended and said 60% of said cost, and the cost of intersections, of said improvement to be borne by the City, are now estimated to be \$20,500.00; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That there be, and there is hereby appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$20,500.00 to pay said portion of the cost of said improvement so to be borne by the City.

Section 2. That Section 6 of Ordinance No. 57-42 be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
