ORDINANCE NO. 38-48

Appropriating money for expenses of Recreation Board.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That whereas bills have been presented to the City by the Board of Education of the City of Bexley for the use of facilities for recreational purposes, by reason of the temporary occupancy of the Jeffrey house by the nurses of the Children's Hospital, in the sum of \$270.00, in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance No. 37-47, the sum of \$212.00 is hereby appropriated from the general fund for the payment of said bills, and the Auditor is authorized to issue proper vouchers in payment of said bills upon approval thereof by the Director of Recreation, or the Chairman of the Recreation Board.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
