By Mr. Helmbrecht

Providing penalty for petit larceny.

Section 1. Whoever steals anything of the value of less than \$35.00 shall be deemed guilty of petit larceny, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not to exceed \$50.00. together with the costs of prosecution.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
