WHEREAS, the public interest demands the improvement hereinafter described, and WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Bexley, State of Ohio, desires to cooperate with the Department of Highways, State of Ohio, in accomplishing said improvement, NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the public interest demands the improvement, under the provisions of the General Code of Ohio, of that part of U. S. Highway No. 40, situate in the City of Bexley, County of Franklin, and State of Ohio, and more particularly described as follows:

Being South Drexel Avenue in the City of Bexley, from East Broad Street to East Main Street, said improvement to consist of widening the roadway thereof from East Broad Street to Powell Avenue, and re-surfacing said roadway from East Broad Street to East Main Street with bituminous concrete.

Section 2. That the Council of the City of Bexley, State of Ohio, does hereby propose to cooperate with the Department of Highways, State of Ohio, in said above described improvement by paying the entire cost of engineering in connection with said improvement, and paying 35% of the cost of construction, the said Department of Highways to pay the remaining 65% of the cost of construction.

Section 3. That this resolution be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
