

ORDINANCE NO. 4-49

Accepting easement of Eugene E. Baldwin and Floss F. Baldwin for sewer purposes.

WHEREAS, Eugene E. Baldwin and Floss F. Baldwin have executed their certain easement to the City of Bexley, Ohio for the purpose of constructing, operating, maintaining, repairing, cleaning and caring for a sanitary sewer over and through the following described real estate, situate in the County of Franklin, State of Ohio and City of Bexley, to-wit:

Being a strip of ground five (5) feet in width off of the north side of Lot No. Three (3) of block seven (7), Amended Plat of Ballitt Park Addition in said city of Bexley, and

WHEREAS, Council is of the opinion that it will be to the best interest of the City to accept said easement, NOW THEREFORE: BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the above mentioned easement, bearing date of the 7th day of February, 1949, executed by Eugene E. Baldwin and Floss F. Baldwin to the City of Bexley, conveying to the City of Bexley a right of way and easement over and through said premises therein described for the purpose of constructing, operating, maintaining, repairing, cleaning and caring for a sanitary sewer therein be and the same is hereby accepted, and the Clerk is hereby directed to certify upon said easement the acceptance thereof by Council of this ordinance, and is hereby directed to file the same for record in the Recorder's Office of Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
