

## RESOLUTION NO. 4-49

Appointing board to report estimated assessment to pay the cost and expense of improving Powell Avenue from Parkview Avenue to Drexel Avenue.

Whereas, it has been determined by council to assess the entire cost of the improvement of Powell Avenue from Parkview Avenue to Drexel Avenue, less 60%, and the cost of intersections, upon the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said improvement, said assessment to be in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvement, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLADEL, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Dana Whiting, William Graessle and James Dixey, three disinterested free-holders of said City, be and they are hereby appointed a Board to estimate the assessment of such cost on the lots and lands to be charged therewith, as set forth in Ordinance No. 5, to improve said street, passed November 27, 1942, in proportion as nearly as may be to the benefits which may result from the improvement to the several lots or parcels of land so assessed and report to this council the said estimated assessment.
