By Mr. Helmbrecht

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

That sidewalks shall be constructed on the south side of Main Street, in the City of Bexley, between the following points, to-wit:

Beginning at a point 81 feet east of the east line of Euclaire
Avenue and extending eastwardly to the east line of Lot No. 7 of
Bexley Plaza Addition, a distance of approximately 205 feet.

Said sidewalks shall be constructed of concrete and shall be of the uniform width of five feet; they shall be constructed in accordance with the plans and specifications for sidewalks heretofore adopted by Council and now on file in the office of the Mayor; they shall be constructed with a cross-slope of 3/8 of an inch per foot, and shall be placed with the inside edge, being the edge next to the lot line, 5 feet from the lot line, and at an elevation above the curb grade of 3/8 of an inch for each foot that the sidewalk is distant from the curb, plus one inch rise from the curb; the foot of the terrace slope of any lot shall not extend into the street beyond the property line.

That the Clerk of Council shall, and he is hereby directed to, cause a written notice of the passage of this resolution to be served as required by law.

In the event that the Superintendent of Streets shall find that any part or parts of said sidewalk existing between said points is in a good and safe condition of repair and is at an elevation heret fore provided by the City, which elevation is required to be changed to comply with the foregoing described elevations, the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into such agreement with the abutting property owner or owners for such division of the cost of constructing a new walk at such locations as he may deem to be just and equitable between the City and such abutting property owner or owners.
