To narrow Pleasant Ridge Avenue at that point west of Francis Avenue where the same turns in a northerly direction, being approximately 237 feet from Francis Avenue, by vacating the parcel hereinafter described.

WHEREAS, on the 13th day of September, 1949, a petition and consent of the owners of all the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon that part of Pleasant Ridge Avenue at a point approximately 237 feet westwardly from Francis Avenue within and opposite the tract hereinafter described, was duly presented to Council praying that said Avenue be narrowed at said place by vacating the parcel hereinafter described, and.

WHEREAS, Council upon hearing is satisfied that there is good cause for said narrowing and said vacation as prayed for, and that the same will not be detrimental to the general interests, and further finds that said petition and consent have been signed by all of the owners of the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said Avenue at said point, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Pleasant Ridge Avenue at a point approximately 237 feet westwardly from Francis Avenue, where said Pleasant Ridge Avenue turns in a northerly direction, be narrowed by vacating the following described premises, to-wit:

Situate in the State of Ohio, County of Franklin and in the City of Bexley and being part of a parcel out of Lot No. 1 of an unrecorded subdivision by C. H. Brooks of Lot No. 1 Edward Livingston Heirs Subdivision, and being part of a parcel conveyed by Carl T. and Alice I. Miller to the City of Bexley and shown of record in Plat Book 1430, page 174, Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point at the northwest corner of the above mentioned parcel conveyed to the City of Bexley; thence with the north line of said parcel Easterly, 4.9 ft. more or less, to a point 30 ft. radially from the center of Pleasant Ridge Avenue; thence Southeasterly, across said parcel, along a curve having a radius of 85 ft. and parallel to the center of Fleasant Ridge Avenue

conveyed to the City of Taxley to which point measures 42 ft.

thence along the does line of a point at the southerst corner of some cel; thence with the south line of said corner of said parcel; thence with the south the country, 30 ft. to a point at the conveyed to the City of Bexley, Northerly, 50 ft. to the place of beginning, containing 1,610 square feet, more or less.

Reserving, however, unto the City and public and quasipublic corporations, now or hereafter, holding franchises and
permits from the City for supplying of water, gas, electricity,
telephone service, all necessary easements in, under or over
said portion of said street, for the purpose of sewers, mains,
poles, wires and conduits and maintaining and keeping them in
repairs so far as the City may deem necessary to supply its
inhabitants with public utility service, sewers and drains.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
