

ORDINANCE NO. 28-49

Providing for reimbursement of abutting property owners on East Main Street for the payment of that portion of the cost of constructing sidewalks which is chargeable to the City of Bexley. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That, whereas, in accordance with Resolution No. 6-49 providing for the construction of sidewalks on the south side of Main Street at a point beginning 81 feet east of the east line of Euclaire Avenue and extending eastwardly to the east line of Lot No. 7 of Bexley Plaza Addition, a distance of approximately 205 feet, the Mayor was authorized to enter into an agreement with the abutting property owners for such division of the cost of constructing a new sidewalk as he might deem to be just and equitable between this City and abutting property owners, the Mayor did enter into an agreement with said property owners, agreeing that said property owners should in accordance with said resolution proceed to construct said sidewalks and that the City would allow and contribute to the expense of such construction the following sums, to-wit:

and, whereas, said abutting owners having constructed said sidewalks to the satisfaction of the City, and having paid in full the cost thereof, it is hereby ordained that each of said property owners shall be reimbursed in the several amounts hereinabove set forth, in accordance with said agreement, and in payment of the City's portion of the cost of said construction, and the Auditor is hereby authorized to issue the vouchers of the City in payment thereof.

Section 2. That the sum of \$248.13 be and the same is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the above purpose.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
