Authorizing the purchase of one Crawler Type Tractor for municipal purposes, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXIEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor be and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of one crawler type tractor, equipped with bull clam shovel, in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the Mayor, same not to exceed \$10,500.00 in cost. Bids shall be received by the Mayor for said purchase, with or without the exchange thereon of one secondhand I-6 International Tractor, No. IBK 22764, Engine No. IBKM 18714, with Hough high lift loader, No. 35567.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertising according to law. The sum of \$10,500.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said tractor is necessary for the daily operations of the city's governmental functions and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
